

Tips and Tricks

ROSTER TIPS

- Standard and concession members are expected to sign up for at least 4 shifts per year (super fun and kids can come along).
- When signing up online, unless you're confident on opening/closing the toy library, don't choose the "coordinator" role.
- Detailed instructions are included as a pdf attachment in this email, and a link will be included in your automatic reminder email.
- All members (except casual members) are expected to take part in two events each year.

BORROWING TIPS

- Choose age appropriate toys to ensure no harm comes to you child and no damage is done to our toys through improper use.
- Make sure to check if there is an accessory bag with your item when you are at the checkout.
- Count pieces & check against email receipt before playing if there are missing pieces that are not yet listed then email the committee immediately so that you are not fined for these missing pieces.
- If toys do get lost or damaged, or are returned late, please pay your fines with a sense of pride this is part of our fundraising process
- Please remember to clean your toys before returning them, and if in the process you notice the labelling is coming off grab a permanent marker and remark them yourself as a service to the Toy Library, or alert the member on duty to the fact that some pieces need remarking.
